If you find yourself trapped during a hurricane without a working cell phone, you may <u>still</u> have a way to call for help. A Family Radio Service "Walkie Talkie" can be heard by rescuers in the area. And it's as easy as 1... 2... 3....

Here's what to do: If you have no cell phone coverage, at the top of each hour, turn on your FRS Walkie Talkie and call on channel <u>ONE</u> for <u>TWO</u> minutes with any privacy codes turned off. Say your name, your location, and your emergency.

For example: "Emergency! This is John Smith, 12 miles South of Interstate 10 on Route 7 and my car won't start. Please send help."

Then listen for <u>THREE</u> minutes for an answer. If you <u>don't</u> hear one, save your batteries by turning off your walkie talkie and waiting until the top of the next hour to call again.

It's as easy as 1... 2... 3....

Every hour <u>call</u> on channel <u>ONE</u> for <u>TWO</u> minutes and <u>listen</u> for <u>THREE</u> minutes.

Even if your cell phone doesn't work, you can still call for help using your FRS Walkie Talkie.
