

:60 National SOS PSA -- HURRICANE

If you find yourself trapped during a hurricane without a working cell phone, you may still have a way to call for help. A Family Radio Service "Walkie Talkie" can be heard by rescuers in the area. And it's as easy as 1... 2... 3....

Here's what to do: If you have no cell phone coverage, at the top of each hour, turn on your FRS Walkie Talkie and call on channel ONE for TWO minutes with any privacy codes turned off. Say your name, your location, and your emergency.

For example: "Emergency! This is John Smith, 12 miles South of Interstate 10 on Route 7 and my car won't start. Please send help."

Then listen for THREE minutes for an answer. If you don't hear one, save your batteries by turning off your walkie talkie and waiting until the top of the next hour to call again.

It's as easy as 1... 2... 3....

Every hour call on channel ONE for TWO minutes and listen for THREE minutes.

Even if your cell phone doesn't work, you can still call for help using your FRS Walkie Talkie.
